TOXIC GAS LEAK

COMMUNITIES OF BHOPAL INDIA

Thirty years ago, between 7,000 and 10,000 people died within three days of a toxic gas leak at a pesticide factory in Bhopal, central India. Thousands of survivors and their descendants have suffered long-term health problems. What's more, contamination from chemicals left at the abandoned factory site continues to a pose a serious health risk for the local community.

Demand justice – urge the Indian government to clean up the site and ensure the companies responsible are held to account.
