## MUHAMMAD BEKZHANOV UZBEKISTAN

In 1999, Uzbekistani security forces tortured journalist Muhammad Bekzhanov, editor of a banned opposition newspaper. They beat him with rubber truncheons, suffocated him and gave him electric shocks until he confessed to "anti-state" offences. A judge used Muhammad's "confession" to send him to prison, where he remains to this day.
